Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.

Negative Coggins tests (dated within the last 12 months with horse's name as appears on registration papers) must be available for submission to Show Management. All horses entering the grounds must register with Show Management, show proof of negative Coggins test, and pay grounds fee.

Contestants competing for high point must enter at least 5 classes. Halter counts as one of the classes but is not required.

High point awards in all age groups are determined on a one-horse/one-rider basis. Ties for high point will be broken by the horse/rider combo that wins the most first, second, thirds, etc.

\$25.00 service charge will be charged on each returned check to cover the collection charges incurred. ALL INSUFFICIENT CHECKS WILL BE TURNED OVER TO THE COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR COLLECTION.

This facility offers a covered show arena for protection from the weather. Lunch and refreshments will be available on the show grounds. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the grounds. Dogs will not be allowed to run loose and must display current rabies tags.

The show will operate on a two-minute gate rule. Once the class is asked to enter the arena, all exhibitors have two minutes to enter the gate. Exceptions will be granted to exhibitors who notify the gate person of the need for a tack change, and a reasonable amount of time will be allowed to complete the change.
